



Mendocino College

Mendocino College is a California public two-year institution located in rural Northern California and serves over 5,000 students. Averaging fewer than 25 residents per square mile, with their unique geographic and demographic landscapes, Mendocino and Lake Counties are quintessential examples of rural America. President Powell had the opportunity to visit the main campus in Ukiah earlier this year and was struck by the rolling hills and how the campus seamlessly fits into the surrounding nature.

In addition to the main campus and three centers, President Tim Karas shared that dual enrollment and community partnerships are critical strategies to increase access to higher education to every community in Lake and Mendocino Counties.
