Subject: Fiscal Advisory Committee

Federal regulations require regional accreditors to monitor the fiscal stability of their member institutions. To fulfill this obligation within our core values of collegiality and peer review, the Commission’s fiscal advisory committee is reviewing ACCJC’s current fiscal monitoring metrics, processes, and structures. Using the peer review model, the advisory committee will develop a more precise and holistic definition of “fiscal health.” The committee will also revise the methodology, criteria, and rubrics it uses to review the fiscal health of member colleges based on their annual financial reports. These changes are intended to help institutions both monitor and demonstrate fiscal health and thus support their missions. In support of this goal, a member of the committee may reach out to your institution to obtain additional information or to verify the accuracy of our data.
