Each registrant will be provided the opportunity to indicate whether they would like to make a public comment during the registration process, and if so, must identify the agenda item(s) they wish to address. Please note that no reference to specific individuals or institutions may be made during public comment. Those who are making public comment must either call in by phone or have access to a computer-based microphone to make their comment.
