SUBJECT: Amendment to the Governor's First Amendment to the Declaration of Ongoing Public Health Emergency and State of Emergency

In accordance with the attached amendment and effective today February 2, 2021, the American Samoa Community College will reinforce the following requirements:

(A) Social distancing and mask use required.

- a. As a government agency, ASCC will require social distancing and mask use inside any building on the premises of the ASCC campus.
- b. All persons (faculty, staff, students, and guests) must wear masks in classrooms, offices, and inside facilities
- c. Every person who is gathered at a public gathering such as assemblies, events, meetings, forums, etc. held in a facility on the campus must wear a mask.
- d. Every employee who occupies or drives an ASCC licensed vehicle (CC) must wear a mask.

(B) Subparagraph(s) a. – d. do not apply to (*as per attached memo*)

i. Children under the age of 2 years of age,

- ii. A person who cannot wear a mask or cannot safely wear a mask, because of a disability as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (42 U.S.C. 1202 et seq),*
- iii. A person for whom wearing a mask would create a risk to workplace health, safety, or job duty as determined by the relevant workplace safety guidelines or regulations; and*
- iv. A person who is the sole occupant of a vehicle or office.*

Let us as an institution of higher learning be responsible for implementing all procedures to ensure the safety and health of our employees, students, and those we serve.
