<b>Standard I: Developmental Passing Rates</b>	Total number of ENG 90,91 and Math 90 students who passed, divided by the total number enrolled in those courses
<i>- ENG 90</i>	Number of ENG 90 students who received a C or better divided, by the number of students taking ENG 90
<i>- ENG 91</i>	Number of ENG 91 students who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking ENG 91
<i>- MAT 90</i>	Number of MAT 90 students who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking MAT 90
<b>Standard II: Gateway "C" or Better</b>	Total number of students who complete ENG 150, 151 1nd MAT 90 with a C or better, divided by the total number of students enrolled in Gateway courses.
<i>- ENG 150</i>	Number of ENG 150 students who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking ENG 150
<i>- ENG 151</i>	Number of ENG 151 students who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking ENG 151
<i>- MAT 151</i>	Number of MAT 151 students who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking MAT 151
<b>Standard III: Program Requirements "C" or Better</b>	Total number of students who passed 1st Year Gen Ed, 2nd yr Gen Ed and Program Requirements with a C or Better, divided by the total number enrolled in those courses

<i>- First Year General Education</i>	Number of students in 1st Yr Gen Ed who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking 1st Yr Gen Ed courses
<i>- Second Year General Education</i>	Number of students in 2nd Yr Gen Ed who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking 2nd Yr Gen Ed courses
<i>- Program Requirements</i>	Number of students in Program Requirement courses who received a C or better, divided by the number of students taking Program Requirement courses
<b>Standard IV: Persistence</b>	
<i>- First Year Retention (Fall -Spring)</i>	Number of students in Fall Cohort who re-enroll in following Spring semester, divided by the number of students enrolled in that Fall cohort.
<i>- Second Year Retention (Fall-Spring-Fall)</i>	Number of students in the First Year Retention who enroll in the following Fall, divided by the number of the Fall Cohort
<b>Standard V: Degree and Certificate Completion, and Career Technical Education</b>	
<i>Percentage of Graduates that complete Associate Degrees.</i>	Number of Graduates in this semester who complete an Associates Degree, divided by the total of number of graduates for this semester.
<i>Percentage of Graduates that complete certificates of Proficiency</i>	Number of Graduates in this semester who complete a certificate, divided by the total of number of graduates for this semester.
<i>Percentage of graduates that complete the Bachelor of Education in Elementary Education</i>	Number of Graduates in this semester who complete a Bachelor's degree, divided by the total of number of Bachelor graduates for

Standard 6: Graduation Rates	
<i>-150% of Normal Time to Completion</i>	Number of Graduates who complete a degree within 150% of NTC (6 semesters Fall and Spring only), divided by the total number of graduates.
<i>- Transfer to other institutions of Higher Learning</i>	Number of graduates who received scholarships, divided by the total number of graduates.
<i>- Transition into the Workforce</i>	Number of graduates in CTE programs who transitioned in the workforce, divided by the number of graduates in that program.
