Position Title: Livestock Technician

General Description:

Under the general supervision of the Agriculture Extension Program Manager (AEPM), the Livestock Technician works directly in providing manual labor and general support for the implementation of Livestock Farms and Demonstration projects.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Care of livestock, including daily feeding of pigs and cleaning of facilities
- Securing of pigs and all equipment
- Collection of composting materials and doing composting projects
- Operation of the Wood-chipper machine
- Maintenance of the pig demonstration unit located on ASCC-ACNR campus
- Control of Animal Pests and Diseases
- Cleaning and maintenance of project tools, equipment, machinery and vehicles
- Assistance to all extension programs and Agents with demonstration and presentations
- Following the plan of work prepared by the Agriculture Extension Program Manager
- Performing other duties as assigned

Minimum Qualifications:

- Two years of experience in agriculture or related field

- Associate of Science degree in Agriculture, Natural Resources, Animal Science, and/or Horticulture
