General Description:

The Research Assistant I (Horticulture) assists the Horticulture Researcher in implementing and maintaining horticulture research trials, projects, and programs.

Responsibilities and Duties:

- Perform duties such as maintenance of field plots, trials, laboratory and equipment; plant propagation and distribution of planting material
- Visit farms to assist farmers with identifying and developing solutions to horticulture related questions/problems
- Prepare and conduct presentations/workshops to farmers, students, community groups and media
- Assist Researcher and Research Assistant II in developing and conducting field and greenhouse plot layout.
- Assist with field preparation, planting, harvesting/data collection, pest control, weed management and lab tests
- Other duties as assigned

Minimum Qualifications:

- Associate's degree in Agriculture, Biology, tropical plant and soil science, natural science or a related field
- Two to three years of directly related experience
- Ability to operate manual transmission vehicle
- Ability to communicate in English and Samoan
- Basic understanding of soils and agriculture in American Samoa
- Ability to work with minimal supervision and to supervise Research Technician in daily activities
- Ability and willingness to perform moderately strenuous outdoor labor
- Ability to safely operate rototiller, weed eater, backpack sprayer, hedge trimmer, pick, hoe, shovel, bush knife and other tools required for plant propagation and plating
- Understanding of and adherence to farm safety practices (chemical, physical biological)
- Must pass the American Samoa EPA Pesticide Applicator Safety Course
